The second course is Marine Diesel Engines for Beginners - this course will cover how an engine works, bleeding your fuel system, changing filters and impellers, how to identify potential problems, basic electricals, exhaust systems, and much more. Both courses will be held at the Marine Stainless Workshop in North Manly where Laurence has a full workshop.
