NEWS FROM BAVARIA YACHTS IN SOUTH QUEENSLAND

In a further expansion of the "BAVARIA YACHTS" promotion effort in Moreton Bay - Queensland, Australiawide Boat Sales in Newport and Manly are sponsoring the SAGS event held at the Moreton Bay Boat Club situated on the northern tip of the Redcliffe Peninsula. As Brisbane expands northwards, sailing in this area has been steadily growing because of the huge expanse of uncluttered, protected water between the mainland and Moreton Island.

As with most yacht clubs, SAGS racing is keenly supported because of its relaxed nature. To add an extra dimension to this form of racing, the club's sailing committee introduced a "handicap start", so that the slower boats

start earlier than the fast boats, resulting in the fleet of some 30 yachts "bunching up" after rounding the last mark and crews having to use their tactical skills to sail into the lead before the finish.

This unsponsored SAGS racing is held weekly, and provided Australiawide Boat Sales with an opportunity to promote BAVARIA YACHTS to a wide audience in this growing market. It was decided to spread the sponsorship over the full sailing season with a nominated race each month, and major prizes presented on Trophy Night in June 2008. It seems the choice of 3 bottles of Bundaberg rum for the 3 top placegetters in the monthly BAVARIA YACHTS race has proven extremely popular.
