Bavaria Yachts Australia and Allsail Yachting Adventures invite you to join the Australian team for the third International Bavaria Cup to be held on the fabulous sailing grounds of the Croatian Dalmatian coast and islands.

For its first participation in this event Bavaria Australia team will be a Match 42 and a Bavaria 47 Cruiser - both racing with spinnakers. Each yacht will have 7 to 9 crew and spinnaker training will be available before departure for overseas if required.

The event is being run at the end of season when winds are up but costs are down – and the price has been subsidised by Bavaria to get our Australian challenge going. Airfares at this time are also very attractive.

So if you are a serious sailor or couple and want to participate in an affordable Mediterranean regatta then this is for you. See over for more information on how the regatta works and terms and conditions.

How it all works and terms and conditions for participation in the Bavaria Cup Croatia 2010

Your hosts for this regatta are Bob Mulkearns from Bavaria Australia and Russell Waddy from Allsail. Both Bob and Russell have recently been in Croatia researching and planning the Australian participation in this event. Your organiser, Allsail Yachting Adventures has been conducting sailing tours in the Mediterranean for over 12 years - including a group of 22 cruisers to Croatia in June this year.

The event is being run by Bavaria Yachts Russia, Adriatic Challenge Croatia and the Yacht Club Biograd – with an ISAF led race committee. Racing is in three categories - Bavaria 42 Match, Bavaria47s with spinnaker and Bavaria 46 cruisers non spinnaker.

Included in the base cost*

- 9 days and nights aboard a luxury fully equipped yacht, all regatta and racing fees
- Port fees and yacht fuel etc
- Commemorative sailing vest, long sleeve top and cap
- Gala dinner, official opening of the regatta and entertainment on Sunday 24 October
- Welcoming drinks at nightly prize giving ceremonies – live music and dancing at most
- Goulash parties at YC Biograd on Saturday 30 October
- Gala dinner, final prize giving to regatta division winners on Sunday 31 October

Not Included

- Air travel and taxes, transfers, taxis, excursions - any other accommodation required
- Yacht security bond – shared credit card deposit at the base and refundable if no damage
- Personal travel insurance, personal expenses, meals and drinks - other than as above

* We have initially booked a Bavaria Match 42 and a Bavaria 47 Cruiser equipped for spinnaker racing and comfortable overnight accommodation. The price is based on 7 passengers on the Match and 8 on the 47 Cruiser.

Subject to crew mix a surcharge of up to \$900 may apply for singles wanting their own cabin. Singles sharing a double cabin will be provided with lee cloth separation or the like. Please note that yacht configurations and other components of the package may vary due to availability and other circumstances. Final racing itinerary may also vary due to weather and local issues during the regatta.

Arrival airport is Zadar which is normally reached by connections from Rome, Vienna, Frankfurt or London. Transfers can be arranged by bus or taxi to the marina (approx 30 kms).

Yacht departure port is the Kornati Marina, Biograd-na-Moru. We board the yachts on the afternoon of Saturday 23 October 2010. Why not come in a day early and spend Friday night in Zadar and check out this historic city and dine on the waterfront. We can then transfer to the marina on Saturday. Training day is on Sunday with first race on Monday.

We will be pre provisioning for some breakfasts and most lunches and snacks while sailing as appropriate with top ups along the way. Each yacht normally runs a kitty for this purpose. Initial contribution is 100 euro per person.

On nights with no arranged meals we eat in port at fantastic local restaurants which have a heavy seafood bias. The lamb is pretty good too and each town has its speciality dishes. Avoid the deadly Grappa. There is also time planned to get in some sightseeing with visits to fabulous Hvar Town, Primosten and the Krka National park available during the schedule.

Our check out from the yachts is 9am Monday 1 November. Transfers back to the airport at Zadar on Monday can also be arranged depending on individual schedules.

How to pay:

You pay a \$1200 deposit per person to reserve your berth or cabin. This is non refundable if you later pull out unless we fill your spot. Deposits are payable on completion of booking form – asap please as we need to confirm the final yachts. Final payment is due 23 August 2010. Full terms on the booking form.

We can advise re pre and post sailing options. Our travel agent - Discover Croatia - can arrange to book for you. But there are really good alternatives on the net and if you are active you can do some really good deals – both in terms of price and quality of the offer. We recommend you take out travel insurance to protect yourself against unforeseen issues or if you cannot travel.

Talk to Russell or Cherie at Allsail at any time for some hints. You can expect to budget on average 80AUD a single and 120AUD a couple per day for the kitty, food, extras etc - and we usually do it very well for this cost. But it's still easy to spend more or less depending on your style.
